- 1-Wash cloth
- 1-Hair dryer (by approved Gate Clearance; to be secured in locker)
- 1-Clothes hanger (plastic)
- PT Gear not included in Directive #3083, "Uniform/Equipment Issue and Appearance"
  - ▶ 1-Sweatshirt
  - > 1-Sweatpants
  - > 1-Shorts
  - > 1-Sneakers
  - > 1-Athletic supporter

This will provide approved staff the opportunity to perform their assigned duties as Drill Instructors, shower and dress for the day without having to sacrifice personal hygiene.
