Subject: Funeral Arrangements for Trooper Jeremy VanNostrand

Date: November 29, 2018

On Tuesday, November 27, 2018, Trooper Jeremy VanNostrand died as the result of injuries suffered in a motor vehicle accident.

At approximately 7:45 a.m. on Tuesday, Trooper VanNostrand was stopped in traffic waiting to turn into the Fonda State Police barracks when his vehicle was struck from behind by a box truck and pushed into oncoming traffic. His vehicle was then struck by a pickup truck. Trooper VanNostrand was taken to Albany Medical Center where he died from his injuries.

Trooper VanNostrand had served with the New York State Police since 2012. Prior to that, he spent eight years as a Correction Officer, working at Coxsackie Correctional Facility. He is survived by his wife, their daughter, and siblings including Christopher VanNostrand who is a Correction Officer at Coxsackie Correctional Facility.

Off duty NYSDOCCS employees are encouraged to attend the services. Available on duty staff may also attend so long as their attendance does not incur overtime. Uniform staff attending the services shall be in a Department issued Class “A” uniform as specified in Directive #3083, “Uniform/Equipment Issue and Appearance” to include the Garrison Cap and Ike Jacket.
