- I. **DESCRIPTION**: The Niagara Frontier Sub-Area Office is located in the Western Region and is physically located at 460 Main Street, Buffalo, NY. The Bureau is presently staffed with a Bureau Chief, Senior Parole Officers and Parole Officers.
- II. **FUNCTIONS**: The Niagara Frontier Sub-Area Office is responsible for providing parole supervision, re-entry opportunities, and violation processing for parolees located in Erie, Chautauqua, Cattaraugus, and Allegany Counties.
- III. **SERVICES**: The Niagara Frontier Sub-Area Office supervises a parolee population that consists of: Strict and Intensive Supervision and Treatment (SIST) cases; Registered Sex Offenders; Discretionary Sex Offenders; Correctional Offender (COMPAS) Level 1-4 cases; Mental Health cases, and Global Positioning System (GPS) cases.
- IV. **SPECIAL PROGRAMS**: The Niagara Frontier Sub-Area Office is a partner in Operation Gun Involved Violence Elimination (GIVE) in Chautauqua County. The Niagara Frontier Sub-Area Office has six off-site report stations.
