Voting In-Person and Early Voting

In 2020 registered New York State voters can vote three ways: By absentee ballot, in-person early voting, or in-person voting on Election Day, November 3, 2020.

In-Person Voting on Election Day is held at polling locations throughout the state. Polls are open from 6am until 9pm.

Early Voting

New Yorkers can vote early for the November 3, 2020 general election. Early voting starts on October 24, and runs until November 1, 2020. There are nine days of early voting prior to Election Day.
