- I. **DESCRIPTION:** Adirondack Correctional Facility is classified as a medium security correctional facility and is located in Ray Brook in Essex County. This facility is used for the general confinement of males who are older individuals. The facility also has a Special Housing Unit (SHU) and Residential Rehabilitation Unit (RRU) for those serving disciplinary confinement sanctions.
- II. **FUNCTIONS:** Adirondack Correctional Facility offers a full range of programs including: academic education, vocational training, substance abuse education and treatment, transitional services, volunteer services, and group and individual counseling services. Thinking for Change (T4C) and Aggression Replacement Training (ART) are cognitive behavioral therapy programs designed to address the needs of the incarcerated individual. The facility operates as a modified therapeutic community utilizing the Community Lifestyles Program.

Adirondack Correctional Facility is classified as Mental Health Service Level 3, as defined in Correction Law, Section 2 (29).
- III. **CRITERIA:** To be eligible for placement in general confinement, an incarcerated individual must be designated medium security classification or less.
- IV. **PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:** Housing units at Adirondack Correctional Facility consist of single rooms in general confinement, the SHU, and the RRU.
